New to state residence

- You have thirty days to obtain your TN Driver's License
- You must go to a full-service DMV to obtain your new TN driver's license. A List of these full-service centers may be found online; appointments can be made online. Please note that you will not be able to make an appointment for the Rockwood office as they are walk-ins only.
- The following documents are required: previous DL or ID, proof of citizenship, proof of name change (Marriage certificate, divorce documents (if applicable), proof of social security number, and two proofs of TN residency. The complete list of approved documents can be found online. All documents must be original/certified.

Already Existing TN Residents

If you already have a TN driver's license, you may do the following at the Loudon Driver's License Office located in the lower level at **101 Mulberry St, Loudon, TN 37774**:

- Address change (may also be completed online)
- DL and ID renewals
- Real IDs
- Add Veteran Status (DD-214 required)
- Update picture
- Name Change due to marriage or divorce
- Obtain a DL or motorcycle study book
- Replacements (may also be completed online)



We **cannot** do the following services: CDL renewals or medical cards, Permit Renewals, changes with Temporary Driver's License, Issue first time TN DLs and IDs, testing, handle suspended or revoked licenses, etc. If there is a service you need that has not already been mentioned, you may reach the **Loudon Driver's License Office at (865)458-2916** to obtain more information. CDL holders, please note that we can do address changes and real IDs at this office but more specific documents are required; please contact the office for a list of required documents. **The hours for the Loudon DL office are 8-4 Monday through Friday.**

License Plate and Vehicle Registrations

Loudon County residents can obtain or make changes to their vehicle registrations and plates at the Clerk's Office at 101 Mulberry Street, Loudon, TN 37774.
