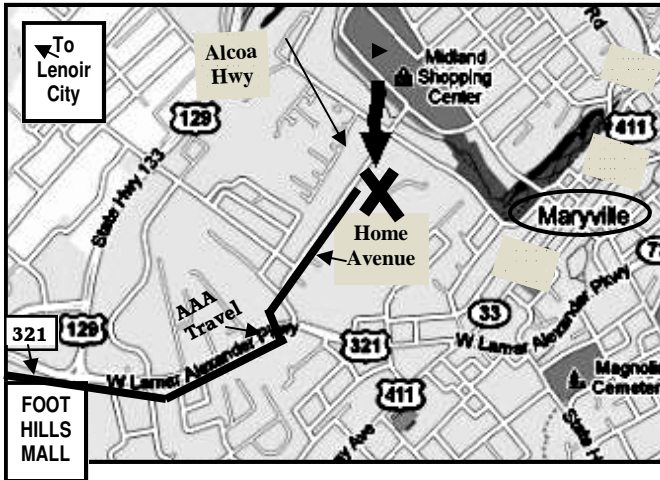

This is NOT official--it's NOT a government document. This brochure is just **my** understanding of the Tennessee Driver's Handbook, the Tennessee website: **www.tn.gov** & the responses of local officials who have patiently answered my questions. It was written to make your move easier. PLEASE let me* know if you find any errors, so I can correct them. Thank you.

Tennessee law requires that you notify the TN Dept. of Safety & Homeland Security of any permanent **change of residence**:
within 30 days if you are moving from out-of-state:

& within 10 days if you already have a TN Driver's License: <http://tn.gov/safety/article/dlchange>

If you do **not** CHANGE YOUR ADDRESS with the Dept. of Safety and are stopped by a law enforcement officer who asks: 'Is this your current address?' you may get a ticket--& be fined hundreds of dollars!

There is also a full-service Drivers Testing Station in Oak Ridge (Anderson Co.) at 475 Oak Ridge Turnpike, Oak Ridge, TN 37830

To obtain a TN **COMMERCIAL Drivers License** (as of Jan. 30, 2012), a **D.O.T. MEDICAL CARD** is required.

Seat Belt Laws in TN

Tennessee requires that ALL vehicle **drivers, front-seat passengers** and **all children** must wear seat belts. Children weighing under 20 pounds must be in rear-facing **approved** carseats and children under 9 years old OR under 5 feet tall **must also be in an approved booster seat**. Violators can be fined \$50 per offense.

For MOVERS who **already have a TN Driver's License**

* issued BEFORE Jan. 1, 2001

2 ways to CHANGE ADDRESS:

1) CHANGE IT ONLINE:

If you already have a **photo** TN Driver's License issued before 2001 or have renewed at least once since, you can CHANGE your ADDRESS **online** at: <https://dl.safety.tn.gov/>

You will receive an email confirmation to **print out** & keep in your car, in case you are pulled over by a police officer. *(It's not required, but you can order a new Drivers License for \$8.)*

***IF you** have had a name change OR if your TN license was issued after 1/1/2001 and you **have not already renewed at least once since**, you can't RENEW or change your drivers license address **ONLINE**, you must change it **IN PERSON**—but you don't need to go to a FULL SERVICE location.

2) CHANGE IT IN PERSON:

When changing your address in person, your photo will be taken and you will receive a paper-copy driver's license for **\$12** (\$16 for duplicates) with that photo, to use **until your hardcopy license** is received in the mail—that usually takes about 2 weeks.

However, **if it is within a year of your renewal date**, you may **renew** your license for \$32 and it will be good for 8 years!

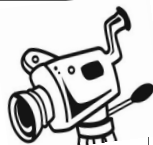

For MOVERS from **OUT-OF-STATE** who **NEED** a **TENNESSEE** Driver's License

There is **NO FULL SERVICE** Driver's License Testing Center (DLTC) in Loudon County. To obtain a TN license, go to the nearest **FULL SERVICE** Station www.tn.gov/safety/article/dllocationserv#full & surrender your out-of-state license, take a counter-top eye test & then **have your photo taken**. The closest **FULL SERVICE** stations to the 37771 & 37772 area are in Blount County (*Maryville*) or Roane County (*Rockwood*) **(There are maps to these 2 on the back of this brochure.)**

A regular license costs \$19.50 & is good for **8 years** from the date it was issued.

You'll also need to bring the right documents:
(no photocopies will be accepted)

1 proof of U.S. Citizenship

(certified or original birth certificate, current passport...)

2 proofs of Tennessee residency

(home insurance policy, a work ID with paycheck stub, mortgage or utility bill with post-marked envelope, current bank statement---no P.O. Boxes ...)

2 proofs of identity

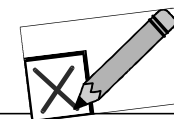
(Primary—with birthdate & full name, driver's license, military ID, marriage license, original birth certificate; passport Secondary—S.S. card, vehicle registration, insurance card...)

1 proof of social security number

(with proof of name change, if required)

1 completed Application for TN Driver's License

To get a copy of your MVR (Moving Violations Record) online for \$7, go to: <https://apps.tn.gov/pmvr/>



Also available at TN Driver's Service Center: You will be offered a chance to **REGISTER TO VOTE** *(you must have a Government issued photo ID in order to VOTE in TN).*

To RENEW or change the address *(within 60 days of moving)* on your **TN Handgun Carry Permit**, go to a **FULL SERVICE DLTC** → www.tn.gov/safety/article/handgunfaqs
