

# LOUDON COUNTY License Plate & Vehicle Registration

Loudon County residents can obtain or make changes to their vehicle registrations and obtain plates at the Clerk's Office (*just inside at the windows on the left*) at 101 Mulberry Street, Loudon, TN 37774.

The office hours are 8am-4:30pm Monday-Friday. A list of the required registration documents and info about handicap placards are online at [www.loudoncountyclerk.org](http://www.loudoncountyclerk.org). Click on 'Motor Vehicles.'

By 2025, there should be an office in Lenoir City (*near City Hall*) on Hwy 321 for annual vehicle license plate and registration renewals. Check the website for the opening date and hours. Limited **Driver's License** services will continue to be offered in **Loudon**—but not Lenoir City.

Other services offered at **Loudon Court Clerk's Office** are:

- **business license**
- **marriage license**
- **register a boat** or watercraft

Information about where to go for passports, hunting & fishing licenses are at the County Clerk website.

## TENNESSEE Driver's License [www.tn.gov/safety/driver-services.html](http://www.tn.gov/safety/driver-services.html)

### NEW-TO-STATE RESIDENTS— to get a Tennessee Driver's License:

- You have **30 days** to obtain your TN Driver's License
- You must go to a **Full-Service Drivers Center** to obtain your new TN driver's license. A list of full-service centers can be found online and an appointment made. Anderson, Blount & W. Knox County are the closest.
- **Required documents** (*also needed for TN REAL ID's*):
  - previous state issued Driver's License or ID
  - proof of citizenship (*birth certificate...*)
  - proof of any name change (*marriage certificate...*)
  - proof of social security number
  - 2 proofs of Tennessee residency (*bills, deeds...*)



- **Documents** must be original/certified. **Other** accepted documents are listed online.

Full-Service Drivers Centers also handle **Handgun carry permits**--information about that is at: [www.tn.gov/safety/tnhp/handgun/faq.html](http://www.tn.gov/safety/tnhp/handgun/faq.html) or call **615-251-8590**.  
(*Most handgun permits from other states are recognized in Tennessee for 6 months.*)

### MOVERS from within TENNESSEE—to change your Driver's License Address go to the **Loudon Driver's License Office**—[www.loudoncountyclerk.org](http://www.loudoncountyclerk.org)/ **downstairs** at 101 Mulberry Street, Loudon, TN 37774

Or, change it online through 'e-services' at [www.tn.gov/safety/driver-services/online.html](http://www.tn.gov/safety/driver-services/online.html)

The Loudon office hours are 8am-4:00pm Monday-Friday (**closed for lunch from 1-2pm**).

Note: this office does NOT do **CDL renewals** (*unless they are downgraded to a Class D*) but can do **CDL changes of address**. For questions, go to the website or call **865-458-2916**.

Other services offered at the **Loudon Driver's License Office** **downstairs** are:

- add **veteran** status to Driver's License (*DD-214 required*)
- **change a name** on a Driver's License—due to marriage, court order or divorce
- obtain a **Driver's Handbook** or motorcycle study book
- obtain a **TN REAL ID**—Starting **May 7, 2025**, everyone over the age of 18 will be required to have a Real ID to board domestic flights or access federal buildings (*aside from federal courts*).

- **renew** a Driver's License or ID
- **replace** a lost or stolen Driver's License
- **update** a Driver's License **photo**
